Eisenbach Consulting, LLC's Electric Generation Supplier License was cancelled on December 17, 2018 by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission. This cancellation was due to an unintentional oversight as we transitioned responsibility for regulatory affairs internally. Eisenbach applied for a new License in 2019 but the application was denied. The COVID pandemic resulted in applicant's failure to reapply. Applicant is applying for a new license.


