Dear Mr. Lent:

By Order entered September 15, 2022, the Commission authorized UGI Utilities, Inc. - Gas Division (the Company) to file a tariff supplement incorporating the terms of the Settlement and changes to its rates, rules and regulations as set for in Appendix A to the Joint Petition for Settlement filed in the above docketed rate investigation, designed to produce a base rate revenue increase of \$49.45 million to be phased in through two steps with the first step of an increase of \$38 million, effective October 29, 2022 and the second step of an additional increase of \$11.45 million, effective October 1, 2023. On October 26, 2022, the Company filed Supplement No. 37 to Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 & 7S to become effective October 29, 2022, along with detailed Proof of Revenue calculations, in compliance with the Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 37 to Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 7 & 7S is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
