This cancellation was due to an unintentional oversight as we transitioned responsibility for regulatory affairs internally. Eisenbach applied for a new License in 2019 but the application was denied. The COVID pandemic resulted in applicant's failure to reapply. Applicant is applying for a new license.**

**Eisenbach Consulting, LLC's Registration as an Energy Agent, Private Aggregator and Energy Consultant for the State of New Jersey Board of Public Utilities expired on October 14, 2016. The expiration was due to an unintentional oversight as we transitioned the responsibility for regulatory affairs internally. All issues have been resolved, a settlement was paid, and Registration has since been reinstated as of May 5, 2020.**

- The Treasurer or other appropriate officer of Applicant shall transmit to the Department of Revenue by March 15, an annual report, and under oath or affirmation, of the amount of gross receipts received by Applicant during the prior calendar year.
- Net Metering Reports: Applicant shall be responsible to report any Net Metering per the Standards on [http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer\\_info/electricity/alternative\\_energy.aspx](http://www.puc.pa.gov/consumer_info/electricity/alternative_energy.aspx). Scroll down to the Net Metering Standards Section.
- Applicant shall report to the Commission the percentages of total electricity supplied by each fuel source on an annual basis per 52 Pa. Code § 54.39(d).
- Applicant will be required to meet periodic reporting requirements as may be issued by the Commission to fulfill the Commission's duty under Chapter 28 pertaining to reliability and to inform the Governor and Legislature of the progress of the transition to a fully competitive electric market.
