Re: Rulemaking to Review Cyber Security Self-Certification Requirements and the Criteria for Cyber Attack Reporting; Docket No. L-2022-3034353

Please be advised that an Advanced Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (ANOPR) was entered in the above-captioned proceeding on November 10, 2022, by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC). The ANOPR will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, and comments may be filed at any time between the date of publication and 60 days following the date of publication. In summary, the ANOPR initiates the PUC's review of its current regulations relating to cybersecurity, including but not limited to 52 Pa. Code §§ 101.1–101.7 (Chapter 101, relating to public utility preparedness through self-certification) and the annual self-certification form and process. Among other things, the PUC seeks comments from interested stakeholders, including motor vehicle carriers, on whether and how to streamline the self-certification form, plan and reporting requirements to better calibrate the benefits of the existing regulations against the burdens they place on regulated entities, especially smaller utilities, and on PUC staff.

Due to the large number of motor vehicle carriers involved, and to the length of the ANOPR, the PUC is providing this notice of the ANOPR via this Secretarial Letter to motor vehicle carriers that are not currently registered in the PUC's e-Filing system.
