To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application has been reviewed and approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). However, before you begin operations, you must file with the Commission all of the information listed in paragraphs (a) and (b) below; Therefore,

YOU ARE ADVISED to contact your insurance agent/broker so that the required evidence of permanent insurance will be filed with this Commission, ONLINE ONLY, via NIC Insurance Filings, at www.nicinsurancefilings.com.

You cannot operate under the approved motor carrier rights set forth in this Letter until all of the information listed below is filed with, and approved by, the Commission.

Once the information listed below is received and approved by the Commission, you will receive a Certificate of Public Convenience, with **PUC No. A-6425533**, which authorizes you to begin operating under the motor carrier rights set forth in this Letter, and compliance with any other provision of this Letter:

- (a) **An acceptable Form E** filed by an insurance company which is binding evidence of bodily injury liability insurance. **Your insurance company must file this form with the exact name of the applicant as it appears on this Letter – Champion Marketing Corp., T/A CMC Transportation. The State MC ID **A-6425533** must be listed to identify your account. All service types covered by this policy must be listed.**
- (b) **An acceptable Tariff**, establishing just and reasonable rates, has been submitted.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH ANY PROVISION OF THIS LETTER WITHIN SIXTY (60) DAYS OF THE DATE OF THIS LETTER WILL RESULT IN THE DISMISSAL OF THE APPLICATION AND REQUIRE THE FILING OF A NEW APPLICATION AND FILING FEE.

Upon issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience you are granted the right to operate as follows:

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons, in paratransit service, between points in the Counties of Washington and Westmoreland, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

The applicant is hereby advised of its obligation to familiarize itself with the requirements of 52 Pa. Code as applicable to the operation of a common carrier as authorized by this Secretarial Letter. Applicant is further advised that failure to comply with all applicable requirements may subject the carrier to penalties, including fines, suspension of operating rights or cancellation of its authority. Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code is available online at www.pacode.com.

Any PUC motor carrier who needs to submit a change of address to the Public Utility Commission, can obtain the Change of Address form from the PUC Website: <http://www.puc.pa.gov/> then select: Filing & Resources, Forms, Motor Carrier Forms.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this Letter.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission must open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by overnight delivery. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.
