**Notification of Implementation of Online LIRA Interface/Application ("Online  
Application") and Final Status Update re: Implementation of the Online Application  
per May 3, 2022 Order of the Commission**

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to Order of the Commission entered on May 3, 2022, in the above-captioned docket, National Fuel's Plan was approved subject to certain conditions which were to be, *inter alia*, addressed in a Compliance Filing of the Plan.<sup>1</sup> Subsequently, National Fuel, *inter alia*, (a) filed a Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration of the May 3, 2022 Order on May 18, 2022 (the "**Petition**"); and (b) filed a Compliance Filing of its Plan on June 14, 2022.

In response to the Petition, on July 14, 2022, the Commission entered an Order at the above-captioned docket, in which it, *inter alia*: (a) determined National Fuel's Compliance Filing made on June 14, 2022 was consistent with the May 3, 2022 Order; and (b) directed National Fuel to "implement all modification to its 2022 USECP approved in or directed by the May 3 Order, except for the [LIRA IT Changes specified in the Petition]<sup>2</sup> within six months . . . and serve a letter at Docket No. M-2021-3024935 when these modifications are fully implemented."<sup>3</sup>

In response to the foregoing, by the filing of this Letter, National Fuel hereby notifies the Commission that the following changes with respect to its LIRA program, as specified in the Plan, have been implemented as of the above-referenced date:

- The LIRA Online Application has "gone live" and is accessible to individuals to use in connection with LIRA via both National Fuel's website and Dollar Energy Fund, Inc's ("**DEF**") (i.e., the third-party vendor's) online website.<sup>4</sup>

Given the implementation of the Online Application as contemplated in the Plan/by the Order has been complete, please allow this Letter to serve as National Fuel's final Monthly Status Update relative to the implementation of the Online Application (as the Order requested National Fuel to provide Monthly Status Updates until the Online Application was complete).


