Thank you for your letter response to our application, dated November 23, 2022. We are pleased to provide this additional information.

- 1) Please describe your commodities in more detail. Are these your products? Are you selling these products at time of delivery? What type of furniture are you delivering and for what purpose?

For nearly fifty years we have been delivering our printed products to customers throughout the Commonwealth, and on rare occasion to contiguous states. The boxes and pallets we deliver contain custom printed material such as newsletters, catalogs, brochures, maps, stationery, cards, etc. Generally, the ownership of these items passes to our customer/client at the time of delivery acceptance.

We now wish to expand the use of our trucks and deliveries to move items for other businesses and individuals. That would include letters, mail, small packages, office supplies, and furniture. Some items may be from retail store to home or office, some to/from customer storage facility, or from one business office/home location to another.

The customers we will service will largely be those who do not have the ability – either staff or trucks – to move these items without assistance. In some cases, time is of the essence and relying on FedEx, UPS, or USPS is a lesser option. For this transport business the ownership of the property in motion remains with the customer.

Our service area will be primarily central Pennsylvania, with deliveries to remote and branch offices throughout the Commonwealth. Items we will not transport are people, animals, dangerous materials, fine art, major appliances, etc. We do not intend to provide long-term storage.


