Re: Agreement of Sale between PECO Energy Company and Caln Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania.


Dear Ms. Choi:

On October 6, 2022, PECO Energy Company (PECO) filed an Agreement of Sale (Agreement) for transfer of facilities to Caln Township (Caln). The Agreement was filed pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §1102(a). PECO is selling to Caln certain assets located within this township. The facilities include 229 street light luminaires, 150 street light brackets, 66 poles, and the existing conductors extending from the luminaires to PECO's secondary wires in the case of aerial fed luminaires for a total purchase price of \$2,407.06. Caln will receive electric service under PECO's Street Lighting Customer Owned Facilities rate (SL-E).

Upon review, the Agreement appears to be reasonable and consistent with the public interest and the Agreement is hereby approved. However, approval of the agreement does not preclude the Commission from investigating, during any formal proceeding, the reasonableness of this Agreement of Sale.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §5.44, file a petition with the Commission within (20) days of the date of this letter. Please direct any questions to Jordan Van Order, Bureau of Technical Utility Services at (717) 787-8763.
