Notice that No Tariff Adjustment is Necessary due to Reduction of the Corporate Net Income Tax

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

This correspondence is in response to the November 9, 2022 Secretarial Letter requiring all jurisdictional fixed utilities subject to Pennsylvania Corporate Net Income Tax ("CNIT") to file an adjusted tariff with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("Commission"). According to that letter, the Commission is requiring utilities to file a recomputed State Tax Adjustment Surcharge reflecting the reduction in the CNIT.

This correspondence is to notify you that Hidden Valley Utility Services, L.P. (Water) (public utility code 210117) will not be filing an adjusted tariff because the company is currently operating at a loss. Consequently, it does not pay corporate net income tax.
