Date began of all services provided is April 15 2010.


2. Eisenbach Consulting, LLC's EGS license previously lapsed due to a failure of preparation and organization, primarily regarding our bonds. We have changed bonding companies, and hired staff tasked specifically with overseeing this part of our operations. Ultimately, as founder and Managing Director, Sandy Eisenbach has taken the responsibility upon himself to personally supervise these critical regulatory operations going forward.

Also, the bond for Eisenbach Consulting, LLC did not lapse. The bonding company used at the time sent the original bond to us by mistake instead of being mailed to the Commission. Due to a transition of personnel at the time, this was overlooked.

3. Three recent consecutive months of bank statements were overnighted as confidential documents to the Commission on December 15, 2022.

4. Eisenbach Consulting, LLC has applied for a Revenue ID Number on December 2, 2022. Per Charity Daniels of the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue, our Request is still in process and due to the conversion of systems, there may be a delay. A new Tax Certification Statement was overnighted as a confidential document to the Commission on December 15, 2022, indicating that our Application is pending. Once we receive our Number, an updated Tax Certification Statement will be overnighted to the Commission.
  
5. Please find enclosed copies of licenses for each state in which Eisenbach Consulting, LLC operates in the electric or natural gas industries.

## DECISION

### I. INTRODUCTION

#### A. SUMMARY

In this Decision, the Department of Public Utility Control grants Eisenbach Consulting, LLC an Electric Aggregator Certificate of Registration to serve residential, commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers in Connecticut.

#### B. BACKGROUND OF THE PROCEEDING

By application filed on February 17, 2010 (Application) pursuant to § 16-245(l) of the General Statutes of Connecticut (Conn. Gen. Stat.), Eisenbach Consulting, LLC (Eisenbach Consulting or Company) applied to the Department of Public Utility Control (Department) for a certificate of registration to operate as an electric aggregator within Connecticut.

**C. CONDUCT OF THE PROCEEDING**

No interested party requested a hearing. Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(l)(4), the Department determined that a hearing was not necessary in this matter, thus, none was held.

**D. PARTICIPANTS IN THE PROCEEDING**

The Department recognized Eisenbach Consulting, LLC, 921 Shiloh Road, STE B300, Tyler, Texas 75703; and the Office of Consumer Counsel, Ten Franklin Square, New Britain, Connecticut 06051, as Participants in the proceeding.

**II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS**

Eisenbach Consulting proposes to serve residential, commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers throughout Connecticut. Application, p. 3. The Company's headquarters are located at 921 Shiloh Road, STE B300, Tyler, Texas 75703. The Company's main telephone number is (800) 977-4020. Application, p. 1. Eisenbach Consulting is a limited liability company formed on May 6, 2004 in the state of Texas. Id. Its contact person for regulatory matters is Sandy Eisenbach. Sandy Eisenbach is the Managing Director of Eisenbach Consulting. Application, Exhibit A-9. The Company has no affiliates or subsidiaries. Application, Exhibit A-11.

Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-245(l)(3), the Company disclosed that neither Eisenbach Consulting nor any of its officers are currently under investigation or have ever been fined, sanctioned or penalized in any state for violation of any consumer protection law or regulation. Application, p. 2. Further, Eisenbach Consulting also affirmed that it will comply with the National Labor Relations Act and the Connecticut Unfair Trade Practices Act and applicable regulations. Application, Affidavit No. 2.

**III. CONCLUSION AND ORDERS****A. CONCLUSION**

After reviewing the Application, the Department grants Eisenbach Consulting a Certificate of Registration to provide electric aggregation services to residential, commercial, industrial, municipal and governmental customers in the state. Eisenbach Consulting is under a continuing obligation to notify the Department of any changes to the information provided in the Application.

**B. ORDERS**

1. Eisenbach Consulting shall inform the Department of any changes to the Company's customer service practices, procedures, or policies in writing at least ten (10) business days prior to the effective date of such changes.

2. Eisenbach Consulting shall maintain its customer complaint records to indicate:  
(1) the date of the complaint; (2) the name and address of the complainant; (3) the address or location cited in the complaint; (4) a description of the complaint; and (5) a description of the resolution of the complaint.



**ORDER NO. 9631**

**AND NOW**, this 29<sup>th</sup> day of July 2020, the Delaware Public Service Commission (“Commission”) determines and orders the following:

**WHEREAS**, on January 22, 2020, Eisenbach Consulting, LLC (the “Company” or “Eisenbach”) submitted to the Commission an application for an Electric Supplier Certificate (“ESC”) to broker electricity in the State of Delaware pursuant 26 *Del. C.* §§ 1001-1020, the Electric Utility Restructuring Act (the “Act”),<sup>1</sup> and 26 *Del. Admin. C.* § 3001, the Commission’s Rules for Certification and Regulation of Electric Suppliers (the “Supplier Rules”); and

**WHEREAS**, the application was deficient in meeting the minimum filing requirements (“MFRs”); therefore, Commission Staff (“Staff”) sent the Company two letters and engaged in information gathering over the course of five months; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 17, 2020, the Company submitted all required documents and thereby filed a complete application (“Application”) pursuant to the Act and the Supplier Rules; and

**WHEREAS**, as more specifically detailed in its Memorandum to the Commission, Staff

reports that the Application fulfills all of the requirements set forth in the Act and the Supplier Rules for an Electric Supplier Certificate to act as an electric broker. In particular, Staff reports that the Company presented evidence to support its financial, operational, managerial, and technical ability to broker Electric Supply Service within the State of Delaware. Therefore, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an Electric Supplier Certificate to authorize Eisenbach to broker Electric Supply Services in the State of Delaware;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE  
OF NOT FEWER THAN THREE COMMISSIONERS:**

1. Eisenbach is hereby granted a certificate to do business and operate as an Electric Supplier within the State of Delaware. Under this Electric Supplier Certificate, the Company is authorized to broker Electric Supply Service within the State of Delaware consistent with and in accordance with the Act and the Supplier Rules.

2. Eisenbach is hereby notified that a violation of any applicable order, statute, regulation, rule, or other controlling authority may be enforced by sanctions in accordance with §§ 1012(a) and 1019 of the Act and § 3001-10.2 of the Supplier Rules.

3. Eisenbach shall file such reports and pay such fees and assessments as may be required or imposed under 26 *Del. C.* §§ 114 and 115, § 1012(c)(2) of the Act, and §§ 3001-3.9 and 3.10 of the Supplier Rules.

4. Eisenbach consents to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of Delaware for all acts or omissions related to its offering of Electric Supply Services in Delaware.

5. Eisenbach is hereby placed on notice that the costs of this proceeding will be charged to it pursuant to 26 *Del. C.* § 114(b)(1).

6. The Commission reserves the jurisdiction and authority to enter such further orders in this matter as may be deemed necessary or proper.

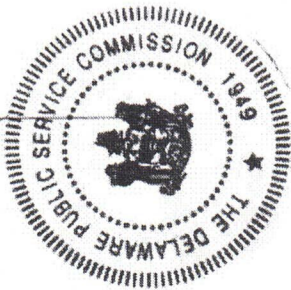

ORDER

By the Commission:

**I. PRELIMINARY MATTERS**

On April 26, 2010, Eisenbach Consulting, LLC (“Applicant”) filed a verified application with the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”) requesting a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant (“ABC”) in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act (“Act”), 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454 (“Part 454”). The Administrative Law Judge requested additional information and clarification of certain matters contained in the Application. The Applicant filed a verified response indicating that it is licensed as an aggregator or broker in six jurisdictions, and that it has had no complaints filed against it for its provision of services in the gas or electric industry. Applicant requests authority to offer services as an ABC for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

**II. REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL APPLICANTS UNDER SECTION 16-115C OF THE ACT**

Applicant is a business organized under the laws of Texas and licensed to transact business in Illinois. Applicant has certified that it will comply with all applicable regulations; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements established by Commission rule; that it will comply with informational and reporting requirements pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Act; and that it will comply with all other applicable laws, regulations, terms, and conditions required to the extent they have application to the services being offered by an ABC. Applicant has agreed to ensure that any person who acts on its behalf will comply with all applicable sections of Part 454. Applicant agrees that it will remain in compliance with the provisions of the Act and Part 454, and will ensure that authorizations received from customers, and all other applicable records are retained for a period of not less than three calendar years after the calendar year in which they were created. Applicant has agreed to adopt and follow rules and procedures to preserve the confidentiality of its customers’ data.

### **III. FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL, AND MANAGERIAL REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 16-115C**

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 454.80 of Part 454, Applicant provided a surety bond in the amount of \$5,000 issued by a qualifying surety authorized to transact business in Illinois. Applicant submitted an original surety bond in satisfaction of Section 454.80.

Applicant is required by Part 454.60 to demonstrate that it meets the managerial qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant must further provide an organizational chart that indicates the position of persons which satisfy the managerial qualification. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the managerial qualifications set forth in Part 454.60, as demonstrated in Attachment 1. The response to the Administrative Law Judge includes an exhibit containing a corporate organizational chart and identifying the persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a). Attachment 1 includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a).

Applicant is required by Part 454.70 to demonstrate that it meets the technical qualifications necessary to provide services as an ABC. Applicant has demonstrated that it meets the technical qualifications set forth in Part 454.70 with the information provided, including the information included in Attachment 2 and the response to the Administrative Law Judge. Attachment 2 includes an exhibit containing occupational background information on the person or persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.70(a).

Applicant further agrees to comply with the Code of Conduct for ABCs contained in Section 454.90.

### **IV. COMMISSION CONCLUSION AND CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY**

The Commission has reviewed the application and attachments along with the supplementary information provided by Applicant regarding the technical and managerial requirements and all other requirements of the Act and Part 454 and finds that the Applicant sufficiently demonstrates compliance with the requirements.

The Commission concludes, therefore, that Applicant's request for a certificate of service authority to operate as an ABC in Illinois should be granted and should include the following authority:

#### CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

IT IS CERTIFIED that Eisenbach Consulting, LLC is granted service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant for the

procurement or sale of retail electricity supply for third parties in the State of Illinois.

## V. FINDINGS AND ORDERING PARAGRAPHS

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Applicant, Eisenbach Consulting, LLC, a business organized under the laws of Texas, seeks a certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant under Section 16-115C of the Act;
- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact;
- (4) Applicant has demonstrated that it possesses sufficient financial, managerial and technical resources and abilities to provide services as an agent, broker or consultant for the procurement or sale of retail electricity supply to third parties in the State of Illinois;
- (5) Applicant has complied with Section 16-115C of the Act and Part 454; and
- (6) Eisenbach Consulting, LLC should be granted the certificate of service authority to operate as an agent, broker or consultant as specified in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that Eisenbach Consulting, LLC is hereby granted a Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker or consultant; said Certificate of Service Authority shall read as that set forth in Section IV of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Eisenbach Consulting, LLC shall comply with all applicable Commission rules and orders now and as hereafter amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.

## I. SUMMARY

Through this Order, Eisenbach Consulting, LLC (Eisenbach or the Company) is issued a license to operate as a competitive electricity provider furnishing aggregator/broker services to all customer classes throughout Maine's service territories pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

## II. APPLICATION AND DECISION

On April 17, 2020, Eisenbach applied to the Commission to operate in Maine as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305. The Company proposes to provide aggregator/broker services to all customer classes throughout Maine's service territories and has met all the Chapter 305 filing requirements.

As a licensed competitive electricity provider, the Company is required to comply with all applicable requirements and regulations, including all conditions of licensing, assignments, customer protection rules, and the filing of annual reports. To the extent that a licensed competitive electricity provider uses third-parties to assist in obtaining customers during the course of its business, Chapter 305 § 4(C) of the Commission's rules places the responsibility on the competitive electricity provider for violations of the provisions of this section by representatives or agents acting on the competitive electricity provider's behalf. Chapter 305 § 2(C)(3) also requires a competitive electricity provider to use reasonable efforts to avoid conducting business with any entity acting as a competitive electricity provider in Maine without a license from the Commission. Therefore, if the Company uses a third party to market its services, it is responsible to ensure that the third party has met any licensing requirements of the Commission.

Pursuant to a Delegation Order dated April 23, 2008 in Docket No. 2008-185, *PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, Delegation of Authority to License Competitive Electricity Providers*, the Commission delegated to the Director of Technical Analysis the authority under 35-A M.R.S. §§ 3203 (1) & (2) and Chapter 305, §2 to license competitive electricity providers. The Commission no longer has a Director of Technical Analysis and all existing delegation orders that delegate Commission authority to the Director of Technical Analysis is now delegated to the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED

1. That Eisenbach Consulting, LLC is hereby issued a license to operate as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules, to provide aggregator/broker services to all customer classes throughout Maine's service territories pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules; and
2. That this license is effective on the date of this Order and valid until revoked or suspended by the Commission pursuant to section 3(A)(4) of Chapter 305, or abandoned by the licensee pursuant to sections 2(D)(10) and 2(D)(11) of Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

## NOTICE OF RIGHTS TO REVIEW OR APPEAL

5 M.R.S. § 9061 requires the Public Utilities Commission to give each party to an adjudicatory proceeding written notice of the party's rights to review or appeal of its decision made at the conclusion of the adjudicatory proceeding. The methods of review or appeal of PUC decisions at the conclusion of an adjudicatory proceeding are as follows:

1. Reconsideration of the Commission's Order may be requested under Section 1004 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (65-407 C.M.R.110) within 20 days of the date of the Order by filing a petition with the Commission stating the grounds upon which reconsideration is sought. Any petition not granted within 20 days from the date of filing is denied.
2. Appeal of a final decision of the Commission may be taken to the Law Court by filing, within 21 days of the date of the Order, a Notice of Appeal with the Administrative Director of the Commission, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S. § 1320(1)-(4) and the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure.
3. Additional court review of constitutional issues or issues involving the justness or reasonableness of rates may be had by the filing of an appeal with the Law Court, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S. § 1320(5).

Note: The attachment of this Notice to a document does not indicate the Commission's view that the particular document may be subject to review or appeal. Similarly, the failure of the Commission to attach a copy of this Notice to a document does not indicate the Commission's view that the document is not subject to review or appeal.

ORDER GRANTING LICENSE

On January 10, 2020, Eisenbach Consulting, LLC ("Eisenbach" or "Company") filed an application ("Application") with the State Corporation Commission ("Commission") for a license to do business as an electricity and natural gas aggregator in the Commonwealth of Virginia.<sup>1</sup>

The Company seeks authority to offer electricity and natural gas aggregation services to eligible commercial, industrial, governmental, and residential customers throughout Virginia.<sup>2</sup>

Eisenbach attested that it would abide by all applicable regulations of the Commission as required by 20 VAC 5-312-40 B of the Commission's Rules Governing Retail Access to Competitive Energy Services.<sup>3</sup>

On February 6, 2020, the Commission entered an Order for Notice and Comment ("Procedural Order") requiring the Company to serve a copy of the Procedural Order on the

appropriate utilities and providing an opportunity for interested persons to comment on the Application. By letter filed with the Commission on February 18, 2020, the Company certified that it had completed the service required by the Commission's Procedural Order. Dominion filed comments on February 28, 2020.

The Procedural Order also directed the Staff to investigate the Application and present its findings in a report ("Report"). The Staff filed its Report on March 13, 2020, which summarized Eisenbach's proposal and evaluated its financial condition and technical fitness. Based on its review of the Application, Staff recommended that Eisenbach be granted an aggregator's license to conduct business as a competitive service provider of electric and natural gas services to eligible commercial, industrial, governmental, and residential customers in the Virginia service territories that are open to retail competition.

NOW THE COMMISSION, upon consideration of the Application, Staff's Report, and applicable law, finds that Eisenbach's Application for a license to provide electric and natural gas aggregation services should be granted, subject to the conditions set forth below.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

(1) Eisenbach is hereby granted License No. A-92 to provide competitive aggregation service of electricity and natural gas to commercial, industrial, governmental, and residential customers throughout the Commonwealth of Virginia. This license to act as an aggregator is granted subject to the provisions of the Retail Access Rules, this Order, and other applicable statutes.

(2) This license is not valid authority for the provision of any product or service not identified within the license itself.

(3) This case shall remain open for consideration of any subsequent amendments or modifications to this license.
