FIRST JOINT STATUS REPORT

I. BACKGROUND

On or about September 29, 2022, Quentin Water Company (Quentin) filed an Application seeking Public Utility Commission (Commission) approval to transfer its water system assets and customers to the West Cornwall Township Municipal Authority (WCTMA). The Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed a Protest on October 31, 2022. Quentin filed a Response to the OCA's Protest on November 7, 2022.

A telephonic prehearing conference was held on November 16, 2022 before Presiding Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Darlene D. Heep. No litigation schedule was established. The OCA requested and Quentin agreed that Quentin would mail a letter to customers explaining the proposed transaction, providing contact information for Quentin and the OCA, and allowing the customers an opportunity to provide comment or objection by December 20, 2022.

On November 21, 2022, ALJ Heep issued Prehearing Order #2, which granted the parties' proposal to submit a status report every 30 days until a hearing date is set. The ALJ directed that the first report should be provided no later than December 21, 2022. The ALJ

further directed that the parties will meet no later than January 10, 2023 to discuss a need for discovery and possible hearing dates.

The OCA and Quentin now submit this First Status Report.

II. STATUS REPORT

1. On November 21, 2022, Quentin provided an affidavit of William Matthews, President of Quentin, stating that the customer letter was mailed to customers on that date.

2. The OCA received informal inquiries from three customers regarding the proposed transaction.


3. As of December 20, 2022, no customers filed comments, objections or protests with the Commission.

4. The parties continue to engage in informal discovery regarding the matters raised in the OCA's Protest and customer inquiries.

III. CONCLUSION

The parties continue to request that no procedural schedule be set at this time so that the parties can focus on discussing the issues with the goal of reaching a resolution that does not require formal litigation. In compliance with Prehearing Order #2, the parties will meet no later than January 10, 2023 to discuss a need for discovery and possible hearing dates. The parties will provide an update to this Status Report on or before January 20, 2022.
