

1. Reference Application, Section 1.a, Identity of Applicant – The applicant stated throughout its EGS application package that the name of the applicant is Snyder Brothers Inc. The PA Department of State states that the applicant’s registered name is SNYDER BROTHERS, INC. (notice the capitalization and punctuation differences). Due to this inaccuracy, please provide a letter that states that the applicant’s name in the EGS application package contains numerous typographical errors and the correct name of the applicant is SNYDER BROTHERS, INC.
2. Reference Application, Section 1.e, Customer Complaints Contact Info – Applicant failed to list the title for its alternate contact for complaints and customer service. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
3. Reference Application, Section 3.a, Affiliates – Applicant failed to list all of its affiliates. Please file an updated application page with the information requested.
4. Reference Application, Section 5.a, Criminal/Civil Proceedings – Applicant failed to provide a satisfactory response to demonstrate compliance. Please provide a detailed response to Question 5.a. If applicant has no actions to list, please list “None” rather than “Not applicable”.
5. Reference Application, Section 5.c, Customer/Regulatory/Prosecutory Actions – Applicant failed to provide a satisfactory response to demonstrate compliance. Please provide a detailed response to Question 5.c. If applicant has no actions to list, please list “None” rather than “Not applicable”.
6. Reference Application, Section 8.a, Technical Fitness – Applicant failed to provide documentation for Technical Fitness. Please provide the missing documentation.
7. Reference Application, Section 8.a, Technical Fitness – Applicant failed to provide a license for each state in which it is licensed to operate in the electric and natural gas industries. Please provide the missing documentation.
8. Reference Application, Section 8.e, Technical Fitness – Applicant failed to provide detailed professional resumes of its chief officers, to include detailed descriptions on all experience and activities including date ranges. Please provide the missing documentation.

9. Reference Application, Section 10.a, PJM Load Serving Entity Requirement – Applicant failed to check the box next to “Acknowledged”. Please provide an updated application page with the appropriate corrections.
10. Reference Application, Section 11, Affidavits – The affidavits submitted list the applicant’s name as Snyder Brothers Inc. rather than SNYDER BROTHERS, INC. (notice the capitalization and punctuation differences). Please resubmit the Application Affidavit and the Operations Affidavit with the appropriate corrections.
11. Reference Application, Section 12, Notarized Proofs – Applicant failed to provide a notarized proof of publication for the Pittsburgh Post-Gazette. Please explain why applicant was unable to acquire a notarized proof for this publication.
