FINAL ORDER

In accordance with the provisions of Section 332(h) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §332(h), the decision of Deputy Chief Administrative Law Judge Joel H. Cheskis dated December 1, 2022, has become final without further Commission action;

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Formal Complaint filed by Jason Ascioffa against PPL Electric Utilities Corporation at Docket Number C-2022-3033094 and dated June 14, 2022, is hereby sustained.

2. That, within thirty (30) days of the date the Commission enters its order in this case, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation shall tender a bill to Jason Ascioffa for the unpaid balance on his electric bill along with a monthly budget amount representing payment for services rendered on a going forward basis.

3. That Jason Ascioffa shall pay PPL Electric Utilities Corporation one-sixtieth (1/60th) of the arrearage owed on the account identified in paragraph 2, plus the budget bill amount as they come due, commencing with the first monthly bill received after entry of the Commission's


Order in this case and continuing thereafter on the due date for the payment of each regular monthly bill.

4. That, as long as Jason Ascioffa complies with the terms of this Decision, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation shall not suspend or terminate his electric utility service except for valid safety or emergency reasons.

5. That, if Jason Ascioffa fails to comply with the terms of this Decision, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation is authorized to suspend or terminate his electric service in compliance with all applicable tariff and regulatory requirements and to take other action permitted by law.

6. That this matter be marked closed.
