To Whom It May Concern,

I am requesting extra time to file Exceptions to the Initial Decision to PUC case C-2022-3032205.

In reviewing the Consumer Complaints Procedure Booklet ([https://www.puc.pa.gov/General/publications_reports/pdf/Consumer Complaints Procedure Booklet.pdf](https://www.puc.pa.gov/General/publications_reports/pdf/Consumer_Complaints_Procedure_Booklet.pdf))

on Friday afternoon January 6, 2023 prior to prepare the filing of Exceptions, page 16 recommends reviewing the transcripts of the hearing to ensure that the filed Exceptions are applicable to the law.

I followed the instructions on page 16 and called the Secretary's Bureau at (717) 772-7777 at 2:12 p.m. (1/6/23) I was referred from the personnel there to call the Records Retention Office at (717) 214-6214. I made that call at 2:14 p.m. (1/6/23). The only option was to leave a voice message for a return call, which I did.

As I had planned to use the weekend of January 7th and 8th to prepare my Exception and file prior to the deadline of January 10, 2023, I require additional time. This would be a minimum of an extra 7 to 10 days. This will allow me to make connection with the Records Retention Office and obtain directions on how to access the transcripts of my hearing during the week, and the time next weekend January 14th and 15th to review the transcripts and prepare my Exceptions.

I require this as I work full time on weekdays and will not have the time to prepare the Exceptions in a timely manner.
