Please find enclosed Supplement No. 4 of the Wastewater tariff of Veolia Water Pennsylvania Inc. F/K/A SUEZ Water Pennsylvania Inc. which includes an update (decrease) to the State Tax Adjustment Surcharge (STAS) from 0.00% to (0.29%) effective January 20, 2023.

The Company interpreted the secretarial letter dated November 9, 2022, to require filing of the surcredit and supporting documents by January 10, 2023 and implementation of the STAS on January 20, 2023 which was incorrect. In order to provide customers the full annual benefit of the Surcredit, the computation is made by dividing the computed annual reduction in state income taxes by projected billed water revenues from January 20, 2023 through December 31, 2023.



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SURCHARGE

STATE TAX ADJUSTMENT SURCHARGE

In addition to the charges provided in this tariff, a surcharge of (0.29%) will apply to all charges for service rendered on or after January 20, 2023.

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The above surcharge will be recomputed, using the same elements prescribed by the Commission.

- a. Whenever any of the tax rates used in calculation of the surcharge are changed,
- b. Whenever the utility makes effective any increased or decreased rates; and
- c. On March 31, 1998, and each year thereafter.

The above recalculation will be submitted to the Commission within 10 days after the occurrence of the event or date which occasion such recomputation; and, if the recomputed surcharge is less than the one then in effect, the Company will, and if the recomputed surcharge is more than the one then in effect, the Company may, submit with such recomputation a tariff or supplement to reflect such recomputed surcharge, the effective date of which shall be 10 days after filing.
