Notification of Full Implementation of National Fuel's Plan

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to Order of the Commission entered on May 3, 2022 at the above-captioned docket, National Fuel's Plan was approved subject to certain conditions which were to be, *inter alia*, addressed in a Compliance Filing.¹ Subsequently, National Fuel, *inter alia*, (a) filed a Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration of the May 3, 2022 Order on May 18, 2022 (the "**May 18, 2022 Petition**"); and (b) filed a Compliance Filing of its Plan on June 14, 2022.²

In response to the May 18, 2022 Petition, on July 14, 2022, the Commission entered an Order at the above-captioned docket, in which it, *inter alia*: (a) determined National Fuel's Compliance Filing made on June 14, 2022 was consistent with the May 3, 2022 Order; and (b) directed National Fuel to "implement all modification to its 2022 USECP approved in or directed by the May 3 Order, except for the [LIRA IT Changes specified in the Petition]³ within six months . . . and serve a letter at Docket No. M-2021-3024935 when these modifications are fully implemented."⁴

In response to the foregoing, by the filing of this Letter, National Fuel hereby notifies the Commission that all changes to National Fuel's Universal Service Programs specified in the Plan have been implemented as of the above-referenced date.⁵

As a result, all references to the "Plan" shall refer to the version of the Plan filed in said Petition and approved in the December 22, 2022 Order.




