Dear Mr. Weinert:

On December 27, 2022, Weinert Appraisal and Depreciation Services, LLC, d/b/a AUS Consultants (Applicant) filed an application to renew registration as a utility valuation expert (UVE) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). UVEs are retained by entities for the valuation of municipal water and wastewater systems under Section 1329 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1329, whereupon UVEs shall determine fair market value in compliance with the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice, employing the cost, market and income approaches.

Upon review of the renewal application as amended on February 2, 2023, it appears the Applicant continues to meet the Commission's minimum qualifications to maintain its UVE registration. Therefore, the Applicant shall remain registered as a UVE on the Commission's Registry of UVEs. **This registration is valid until December 31, 2023. UVEs must re-register by January 1 of each year thereafter to remain on the registry. In addition, the Applicant is advised that if any information in the application changes, it must provide a written notice of said change to the Commission within 45 days of the change.** This approval is not meant to constitute a license, certification or warranty of any kind by the Commission.
