PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS’ MOTION TO CONTINUE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.103, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Thursday, February 10, 2022. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated November 30, 2022, the Commission scheduled an Initial Telephonic Hearing in this matter for Thursday, February 16, 2023 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Marta Guhl.
2. Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.231(a) and the Prehearing Order issued on December 13, 2022, PGW has been working with Mr. Boatwright in attempting to reach a settlement in this matter.
3. It is unlikely that a resolution will be reached prior to the scheduled hearing date.
4. PGW has not had an opportunity to discuss continuing this matter with Mr. Boatwright, but has spoken with his sister, Candice Boatwright who is the co-owner of the service address, regarding the request and she indicated that her brother would not object to continuing this matter to afford the parties a more time to work on a resolution.

WHEREFORE, PGW respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion and continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter to a later date.
