PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS’ MOTION TO CONTINUE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §5.103, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW” or “Respondent”) hereby files this Motion to Continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter, which is scheduled for Wednesday, February 22, 2023. In support of this Motion, PGW states as follows:

1. By notice dated December 5, 2022, the Commission scheduled an Initial Telephonic Hearing in this matter for Wednesday, February 22, 2023 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Marta Guhl.
2. During the pendency of this matter, Mr. Pruitt has filed an informal complaint at Bureau of Consumer Services (“BCS”) Docket No. 3884516 regarding recent unauthorized usage that has resulted in additional charges.
3. The BCS rendered its decision at Docket No. 3884516 on January 30, 2023 and Mr. Pruitt has stated to PGW that he is appealing that decision in a formal complaint.
4. PGW believes it is in the best interests of the parties and serves judicial economy to continue this hearing so that Mr. Pruitt’s appeal of BCS Docket No. 3884516 can be processed and that the resulting formal complaint can be consolidated with this matter.
5. PGW has spoken with the Complainant, Anthony B. Pruitt, via telephone to discuss PGW’s request for a continuance in this matter.
6. Mr. Pruitt has stated that he has no objection to PGW’s request and agrees that the

matter should be continued so that he may have an opportunity to appeal oBCS Docket No. 3884516 and have the cases consolidated for a single evidentiary hearing.

WHEREFORE, PGW respectfully requests that the Commission grant this Motion and continue the evidentiary hearing in this matter scheduled for Wednesday, February 22, 2023 to a later date.
