**PUBLIC STATEMENT OF  
THE OFFICE OF SMALL BUSINESS ADVOCATE**

The Small Business Advocate is authorized and directed to represent the interest of small business consumers of utility services in Pennsylvania under the provisions of the Small Business Advocate Act, Act 181 of 1988, 73 P.S. §§ 399.41 - 399.50 (the “Act”). The Act further provides that the Small Business Advocate is to issue publicly a written statement stating concisely the specific interest of small business consumers to be protected by his initiation of or intervention in any proceeding involving those interests before the Public Utility Commission or any other agency or court. This public statement relates to the filing today by the Small Business Advocate of a Notice of Intervention (“NOI”) in the Investigation of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) into the Estimated Billing of Customers by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL” or the “Company”).

The Small Business Advocate files this NOI to protect the interests of PPL’s small business customers that may have been negatively impacted by the Company’s billing problems.


The Small Business Advocate will participate in proceedings before the Public Utility Commission to investigate the legal issues presented by the Company’s billing problems. The Small Business Advocate will ask the Commission to provide relief to any of PPL’s small businesses that were negatively impacted by the Company’s billing problems, and punish PPL for this error, if just and reasonable.
