Thank you for writing to White Twp., Beaver County to request records pursuant to Pennsylvania's Right-to-Know Law ("RTKL"), 65 P.S. §§ 67.101 *et seq.* On 12-3-21 you requested **detailed monthly tax collector statements for August, September, October 2021 Township and Fire.**

Pursuant to Section 902(a) of the RTKL, an additional 30 days are required to respond because:

- The request requires redaction in accordance with Section 706 of the RTKL.
- The request requires the retrieval of a record stored in a remote location.
- A timely response cannot be accomplished due to bona fide staffing limitations.
- A legal review is needed to determine whether the record is subject to access.

AN ORDINANCE

Signifying and expressing the desire of the corporate authorities of the Township of White, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to increase the indebtedness of said Township by the amount of Twenty Thousand Five Hundred (\$20,500.00) dollars for the purpose of constructing sanitary trunk line sewers, intercepting sewers, manholes, flush tanks and work incident thereto within the Township of White aforesaid; to pay said Township's proportionate share of the expense of the original cost of the Sanitary Sewer Plant of the City of Beaver Falls, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and the main trunk line and appurtenances thereof, and to pay said Township's proportionate cost of the intercepting sewer in the Township of Patterson, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and to pay off the present indebtedness of said Township as evidenced by notes, and providing further for the holding of an election therefore and authorizing and directing the corporate authorities to make the necessary announcements of said election and do all other acts and things incident thereto.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Township Supervisors of the Township of White, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, That the corporate authorities of the Township of White aforesaid hereby signify and express their desire to increase the bonded indebtedness of the Township of White aforesaid by the amount of Twenty Thousand Five Hundred (\$20,500.00) dollars for the purpose of constructing sanitary trunk line sewers, intercepting sewers, manholes, flush tanks and work incident thereto within the Township of White aforesaid; to pay said Township's proportionate share of the expense of the original cost of the Sanitary Sewer Plant of the City of Beaver Falls, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and the main trunk line and appurtenances thereof, and to pay said Township's proportionate cost of the intercepting sewer in the Township of Patterson, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, and to pay off the present indebtedness of said

semi-annually on the first day of the months of May and November in each year, on presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto attached, as they severally become due, without deduction for any tax, except gift, succession or inheritance taxes, which may be levied or assessed thereon or on this bond or on the debt secured hereby pursuant to any present or future law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, all of which taxes the Township of White hereby assumes and agrees to pay, as the same may be, from time to time assessed thereon.

Both principal and interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the John T. Reeves & Co., Bankers, Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania.

This bond is one of a series of twenty-nine (29) bonds of like date, amount and tenor except as to the date of maturity; numbered consecutively from one (1) to twenty-nine (29) both inclusive, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Twenty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000.00), issued in accordance with the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved the twenty-fifth day of June, A.D. 1941, P. L. 159, as amended, and by virtue of an ordinance of the Township of White and the sworn statement of authorized officers thereof, as appears of record in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

It is hereby certified that all acts, conditions and things required to be or be done, happen and be performed precedent to and in the issuance of this bond or in the creation of the debt of which it is evidence, have been done, happened and been performed in regular and due form and manner as required by law; and that this bond, together with all other indebtedness of the said Township of White is not in excess of any constitutional or statutory

Township as evidenced by notes.

That a public election be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be held at the usual hours and places on the second day of November, A.D. 1937, for the purpose of obtaining the assent of the electors of the said Township for the increase of the bonded indebtedness of said Township by the amount and for the purposes aforesaid, and the corporate authorities are hereby authorized and directed to make the necessary announcements of said election and do all other acts and things incident thereto.

That the amount of the last assessed valuation of the Township of White is \$324,000.00, and the amount of the existing debt is \$1790.00. The percentage of the proposed increase of indebtedness is .06327, plus.

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE BONDED INDEBTEDNESS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE, COUNTY OF BEAVER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA BY AN ISSUE OF COUPON BONDS IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$29,000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING UNFUNDED INDEBTEDNESS INCURRED PURSUANT TO AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF BEAVER FALLS, FOR PERMANENT SEWER IMPROVEMENTS; FIXING THE FORM, NUMBER, DATE, INTEREST AND MATURITY THEREOF; LEVYING A TAX FOR PAYMENT OF DEBT SERVICE CHARGES; AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION, SALE AND DELIVERY THEREOF.

WHEREAS it is necessary that the bonded indebtedness of the Township of White, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, be increased by the amount of Twenty Nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000.00) for the purpose of funding unfunded indebtedness incurred pursuant to agreement with the City of Beaver Falls, for permanent sewer improvements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Township Supervisors of the Township of White and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

Section 1. That the bonded indebtedness of the Township of White, County of Beaver, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby increased by the amount of Twenty Nine Thousand Dollars (\$29,000.00), for the aforesaid purpose.

Section 2. Said indebtedness shall be evidenced by twenty-nine (29) general obligation bonds in coupon form, numbered consecutively from one (1) to twenty-nine (29) both numbers inclusive, each in the principal sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), dated and bearing interest from the first day of November, 1965 at the rate of three and three fourths (3-³/₄ %) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of the months of May and November in each year during the term of said bonds which shall mature in numerical order in accordance with Section 210 (d)

of the Municipal Borrowing Law of 1941, as amended, and be paid as follows:

Bonds Nos. 1 to 4, both inclusive, \$4,000, November 1st, 1966
Bonds Nos. 5 to 9, both inclusive, \$5,000, November 1st, 1968
Bonds Nos. 10 to 14, both inclusive, \$5,000, November 1st, 1970
Bonds Nos. 15 to 19, both inclusive, \$5,000, November 1st, 1972
Bonds Nos. 20 to 24, both inclusive, \$5,000, November 1st, 1974
Bonds Nos. 25 to 29, both inclusive, \$5,000, November 1st, 1976

The principal and interest of said bonds shall be payable at John T. Reeves & Co., Bankers, Beaver Falls, Pennsylvania without deduction for any taxes, except gift, succession and inheritance taxes, which may be levied or assessed thereon or on the debt secured thereby pursuant to any present or future law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, all of which taxes the Township of White assumes and agrees to pay as the same may be from time to time assessed thereon.

Section 3. The period of usefulness of the improvements for which an unfunded debt was incurred which is to be funded by the said bonds to be issued, is 20 years.

Section 4. The said bonds are hereby declared to be general obligations of the Township of White and shall pledge the full faith and credit of the Township.

Section 5. The form of said bonds and the coupons thereto annexed shall be substantially as follows:

Section 6. The said bonds shall be executed in the name and under the corporate seal of the Township by the Chairman of the Board of Township Supervisors, attested by the Secretary and

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countersigned by the Treasurer, and the interest coupons shall be authenticated by the facsimile signature of the Treasurer. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to deliver said bonds to the purchaser and receive payment therefor on behalf of the Township after sale of the bonds in the manner required by law; provided, however, that said bonds shall not be sold for less than their par value with accrued interest to the date of delivery and payment.

Section 7. There is hereby levied and assessed upon all persons and property subject to taxation for Township purposes an annual tax in each of the following fiscal years of so many mills as will yield amounts sufficient for the payment from time to time of interest covenanted to be paid on said bonds and the principal thereof at maturity:

which taxes are sufficient for and shall be applied exclusively to said debt service charges as the same shall from time to time become due and payable. The collection of said tax shall commence with the fiscal year beginning 1966 being the first fiscal year following the issue of said bonds.

Section 8. There is hereby established a sinking fund for the payment of the bonds hereby authorized, said fund to be known as Sinking Fund No. 1. All moneys realized from the taxes hereby

levied shall be paid into the sinking fund hereby created as collected, and shall be applied exclusively to the payment of the principal of said bonds at maturity and interest and taxes thereon meanwhile, to which purpose they are hereby irrevocably pledged.

Section 9. All moneys derived from the sale of said bonds are hereby appropriated to the purposes stated and shall not be used for any other purpose.


Section 10. It is hereby declared that the debt to be incurred hereby, together with the existing net debt of the Township is not in excess of any constitutional or statutory limitation and the Chairman of the Board of Township Supervisors and Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to prepare, verify and file with the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Beaver County, the statement required by the Act of Assembly, approved June 25th, 1941, P. L. 159 as amended and to do and perform all other acts proper in connection therewith.

Section 11. All ordinances or parts of ordinances not in accord with this ordinance are hereby repealed in so far as they conflict herewith.
