PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.15(b), hereby requests a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter and states the following:

1. A telephonic hearing in this matter is scheduled to take place on Wednesday, March 8, 2023, at 10:00 a.m.
2. PECO is requesting a continuance of the March 8, 2023 hearing date because the parties have agreed to conduct an in-person high bill field visit at the Complainant’s home, due to his billing dispute.
3. The inspection is scheduled to take place on March 3, 2023.
4. PECO therefore respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to one week from the March 8, 2023 hearing date.
5. The Prehearing Order in this matter states that requests for a continuance are only granted “for good cause.” (Prehearing Order, ¶2).
6. PECO avers that “good cause” exists to continue the scheduled hearing to another date because a high bill field inspection has not yet been conducted.
7. The Complainant does not object to the Continuance.
