
The insurance information on the PA PUC website was checked and it appears that insurance forms E and H are in compliance.

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour considered as one-half hour.

NOTE 4 - Minimum Transportation Charge: Any Day (any hour): 4 hours at rates named in Columns 1 and 2, 3 or 4. If shipment is a piano or safe only or household goods, in use, having a cubic measurement of 200 cubic feet or less, the Minimum Transportation Charges is 2 hours at rates named in Column 1 and Columns 2, 3 or 4.

NOTE 5 - A deposit of \$250.00 is required on all moves. Deposit will be refunded if move is cancelled or rescheduled 10 days prior to the move date. If notice of cancellation is less than 10 days prior to the move date, deposit is non-refundable.

NOTE 6 - If a refrigerator or safe are included in the shipment, a handling fee of \$100.00 per item will apply in addition to all other applicable hourly charges. A special handling fee of \$100.00 will apply for Grandfather Clocks, Arcade and Pinball machines, and Peloton or similar exercise equipment in addition to the applicable hourly charges. The handling fee when an upright piano is included in the shipment will be a \$200.00 fee in addition to the applicable hourly charges. Handling fee in addition to the applicable hourly charges when a pool table is included shipment is \$300.00.

NOTE 7 - If shipment needs to be held overnight, for the convenience of the shipper, a charge of \$200.00 per vehicle per night will apply for vehicle(s) less than 24 feet in length. For vehicle(s) 24 feet or 26 feet in length, charge is \$350.00 per vehicle per night.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.
