#### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

## **ITEM 20** - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

#### **ITEM 30** - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article.

## **ITEM 40** - HOURLY RATES

Rates begin at time of arrival and end at completion. An associated travel time charge will be added as stated under Note AA on Item 300.

## **ITEM 50** - ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

All tolls, parking fees and other out of pocket expenses will be the responsibility of the customer and added to the carrier's charges.

## ITEM 60 - DEPOSITS AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Reservations that require a deposit will be at a rate of 20% of costs. Deposits are subject to forfeiture if 50% if scheduled moving date is cancelled more than 15 days but less than 30 days prior to the move date and forfeiture of the total amount if cancelled 15 days or less of move date.
