STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Interim Order Directing Status Report dated February 14, 2023, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”), files this Status Report as follows:

Following the February 14, 2023 Settlement Conference, on that same day counsel for PGW sent Complainant, Leonard Moore, a written letter enclosing application for PGW’s Customer Responsibility Program (“CRP”) and instructions on how to apply for assistance under CRP, with a submission deadline of February 28, 2023. The same letter included another settlement offer for Mr. Moore’s consideration – a PGW Budget Billing Payment Arrangement. This letter was sent by undersigned counsel to Mr. Moore via email and regular United States Mail.

On February 22 and 23, 2023, undersigned counsel contacted Mr. Moore to follow-up on the recent correspondence so as to continue settlement discussions. The parties discussed the available settlement options. Ultimately, Mr. Moore and his family communicated that he was unable to accept either settlement option and he and his family requested that PGW’s counsel cease communicating with them. Counsel respected their wishes and did not contact Mr. Moore any further.

According to PGW records as of the date of this Status Report, Mr. Moore did not apply for CRP on or by February 28, 2023.

According to PGW records as of the date of this Status Report, Mr. Moore did receive a LIHEAP grant which was posted to his account on February 15, 2023.

Settlement discussions are concluded and were unsuccessful.

Therefore, PGW respectfully requests that Her Honor schedule a hearing on the merits of this matter.
