In accordance with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's ("Commission") Order entered July 15, 2021, Ordering Paragraph No. 3, approving the Joint Petition for Settlement ("Settlement") in the above docket, Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Aqua") is required to provide the parties to the Settlement an annual report regarding Aqua's customer-owned lead service line replacement activities.

Following the Commission's approval of Aqua's replacement program for customer-owned lead service lines, the Commission issued final regulations regarding Act 120 of 2018, which included provisions on annual reporting of customer-owned lead service line replacements in the Annual Asset Optimization Plan ("AAOP") filing. Starting with Aqua's 2022 AAOP, and going forward, information on Aqua's customer-owned lead service line replacements will be included in its AAOP filing.
