ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) for consideration and disposition is a Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration (Petition) filed by the Pennsylvania Coalition of Local Energy Efficiency Contractors, Inc. (PA-CLEEC), on February 23, 2023. PA-CLEEC seeks reconsideration of the Commission's February 9, 2023 Order¹ in the captioned proceeding.

Pursuant to Rule 1701 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Appellate Procedure, Pa. R.A.P. 1701, (relating to effect of appeal generally), the Commission must act to grant a petition for reconsideration within thirty days of the date of entry of the order for

which reconsideration is sought or otherwise lose jurisdiction to do so if a petition for review is timely filed.² The thirty-day period within which the Commission must act on the Petition for Reconsideration in order to preserve jurisdiction relative to the February 9, 2023 Order ends on March 11, 2023. PA-CLEEC has timely filed its Petition. Accordingly, we shall grant reconsideration pending a review on the merits; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

That the Petition for Clarification and Reconsideration, filed by the Pennsylvania Coalition of Local Energy Efficiency Contractors, Inc., on February 23, 2023, is hereby granted, pending further review of, and consideration on, the merits of the Petition.
