Fiber Passings Commitment – 2022

As of January 31, 2023, we met the 2022 premises commitment and are on track to complete this year’s required premise passings by the end of 2023. Listed in the chart below is the validation and identification of those passings into the business and residential categories by Wire Center.

In addition to the fiber builds in the Elizabethtown and Columbia exchanges, Brightspeed also passed 1,589 premises with fiber by December 31, 2022, of which 21 were business premises. These fiber builds were spread across various exchanges in the Brightspeed Pennsylvania footprint and includes fiber passings finished by Brightspeed (e.g. new housing developments).

\*No state broadband grants were pursued or awarded to support these builds.
