LIST OF CHANGES

This Supplement No. 13 cancels and supersedes Supplement No. 11 filed October 31, 2022 and Supplement No. 12 filed November 29, 2022 in accordance with Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Commission's Order adopted and entered on March 2, 2023 at Docket No. R-2022-3036491.

This Supplement No. 13 revises Page Nos. 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 and 6A of Tariff No. 2. Its purpose is to increase the Company's current rates in Part I, Sections A, B, D, and G, and to decrease the PENNVEST Rate (PVR) in Part I, Section H.

PART I: SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

Section A - Rates for Metered Service

1. Customer Charge: Each customer will be assessed a customer service charge based upon the size of the customer's meter as follows:

¾ inch	\$ 15.74 (i)
1 inch	\$ 27.37 (i)
1½ inch	\$ 54.75 (i)
2 inch	\$ 85.54 (i)

4 inch	\$ 256.62 (i)
6 inch	\$ 513.24 (i)

2. Consumption Charge: In addition to the above Customer Charge, the following water consumption charges will apply for water supplied.

Rate per 1000 Gallons

Section B - Fire Protection Rates

1. Private Fire Protection: A customer charge for private fire protection service will be assessed as follows:

2. Public Fire Protection: For public fire protection, the charge shall be \$68.43 per hydrant per quarter. (i)

Section C - Returned Check Charge

A charge of \$30 will be assessed any time where a check which has been presented to the Company for payment on account has been returned by the payor bank for any reason.

Section D - Construction Rates

The flat rate charge for unmetered residential building construction shall be \$68.43 per quarter per dwelling unit under construction until construction is completed. (i)

The flat rate charge for unmetered nonresidential construction shall be \$68.43 per quarter per building or unit under construction until construction is completed. (i)

Section E - Service Termination or Resumption Rates

The fee for shut-off or turn-on of service at the curb stop shall be \$60.

(i) denotes increase
(d) denotes decrease

Section F - Meter Test Rates

Consistent with Commission regulation at 52 Pa. Code §65.8(h), the fee schedule for testing of meters shall be as follows:

1 inch or less	\$10.00
1¼ inch - 2 inch	\$20.00

These amounts may vary without revision of this tariff so as to be consistent with Commission regulations.

Fees for testing meters over 2 inches or for testing meters so located that testing costs are disproportionate to the stated fees shall be as established by the Company based upon the actual cost of the test.

Section G - Bulk Water Sales

For bulk water sales, the charge shall be:

Rate per 1000 Gallons

\$7.98 (i)

(i) denotes increase

Section H – PENNVEST Surcharge

1. For the sole purpose of recovering the Company's principal and interest obligations of PENNVEST Loan No. 80190 used to finance used and useful assets of the Company, a surcharge shall be assessed on all Customer bills. This surcharge shall be uniformly applied as an additional charge on all charges specified in Part I, Sections A, B, D and G of this Tariff.

2. The amount of the surcharge shall be determined as follows:

$$PVS = AC * PVR$$

where $PVR = PI / WR$ and may not exceed 0.4875

PVS = PENNVEST surcharge.

AC = Applicable charge. An applicable charge shall mean any charge on a Customer's bill as specified in Part I, Sections A, B, D and G of this Tariff.

PVR = PENNVEST rate expressed as a percentage and not to exceed 48.75%

PI = Total actual or prospective annual principal and interest obligations of said PENNVEST loan.

WR = Total annual water revenue billed over the most recent consecutive four quarters of service from charges specified in Part I, Sections A, B, D and G of this Tariff.

3. The PVR proposed with this filing shall be:
