SECOND STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Interim Order Directing Status Report dated February 14, 2023, Philadelphia Gas Works (“PGW”), files this Second Status Report as follows:

This Second Status Report is submitted as a further update and supplement to the prior Status Report dated March 1, 2023.

On March 8, 2023, I received an original application for PGW’s Customer Responsibility Program (“CRP”) with supporting documents only from Complainant, Leonard Moore. The application was dated February 28, 2023 and the envelope containing this application was postmarked March 2, 2023. Upon receipt, I immediately forwarded the application and documents to PGW’s Universal Services Department for review to determine Mr. Moore’s eligibility for assistance under CRP. I also sent Mr. Moore a letter which acknowledged receipt of his application and advised of its review by PGW. My March 8th letter was sent by both email and regular U.S. Mail.

Upon review, it was determined that Mr. Moore’s CRP application was incomplete as it was missing the required payment. A letter dated March 8, 2023 was generated by PGW and was mailed out to Mr. Moore, which advised of the incomplete application, the steps necessary to complete the application, and the fourteen (14) day deadline to do so.

On March 9, 2023, I sent correspondence to Mr. Moore enclosing another copy of the March 8th letter and also specifically advised Mr. Moore that: (1) his application was incomplete; (2) the required actions need to be taken by him to complete the application; and (3) the fourteen (14) day deadline. My March 9, 2023 letter was sent to Mr. Moore by both email and regular U.S. Mail.

Another Status Report will be filed on or shortly after March 21, 2023, when the response deadline has expired.

PGW requests that the hearing scheduled for April 18, 2023 remain unchanged.
