Re: PECO Electric Purchase of Receivable Discount Rate Update;  
Supplement No. 32 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 1S

Dear Mr. Webster:

On March 9, 2023, PECO Energy Company (PECO) filed Supplement No. 32 to Tariff Electric Pa P.U.C. No. 1S to become effective on March 10, 2023. The supplement was filed to eliminate the Purchase of Receivables (POR) discount rate associated with the recovery of implementation costs to enable Standard Offer Program (SOP) web enrollment due to completion of recovery.<sup>1</sup> Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and supporting documentation summarizing revenues collected from electric generation suppliers and the implementation cost of SOP web enrollment, and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 32 to Tariff Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 1S is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
