TO PARTIES OF RECORD:

The Complainant sent the attached fax to the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, received on March 22, 2023. *See attachment to Secretarial Letter.*

First, faxed and emailed filings are not acceptable. The Complainant's objection to PECO's Certificate of Satisfaction dated February 27, 2023, had to be filed by either opening and using an e filing account through the PUC's website, or by mail, preferably overnight delivery to ensure meeting the 10-day deadline to object, which was March 9, 2023.

Second, the faxed filing is past the deadline for submission. Although the filing shows a date of March 8, 2023, it had to be received by the Commission on or before March 9, 2023, and by an acceptable method of filing. As stated above, the Secretary received the fax on March 22, 2023. The faxed filing is not only unacceptable due to the method used by the Complainant to file the objection, but also fails to meet the March 9, 2023, deadline. Therefore, the complaint case at the above docket number is now closed.


The Complainant now has two options. First, re-file the formal complaint and begin the formal complaint process again. The Complainant may go to the PUC's website, and obtain a formal complaint form, and file a new formal complaint against PECO Energy. The Complainant will retain his burden of proving his complaint has merit.

In the alternative, the Complainant may file a Motion to Reopen his current complaint case at Docket Number C-2022-3037194 on or before March 27, 2023, by 4:30 p.m. (EST). PECO's counsel is also being served with this Secretarial Letter. The Complainant must serve a copy on PECO's counsel, by email, if the Complainant decides to file a Motion to Reopen. PECO may file a responsive pleading to the Complainant's Motion on or before March 31, 2023, by 4:30 p.m. (EST).

Complainant's Motion must be in writing and explain specifically why he wants the case reopened. The filing must be submitted to the Secretary by either efile using an efile account through the PUC's website, or by overnight delivery which is preferable over first class mail to meet the deadline to file and enable the Complainant to track his filing. The Complainant is directed to include the docket number of his current complaint and a Certificate of Service that he served PECO's counsel with a copy. The Complainant may email PECO's counsel with a copy of his Motion filing.

If the Complainant chooses not to pursue either of these two options, the formal complaint case at C-2022-3037194 is hereby closed and the Certificate of Satisfaction stands.
