SECTION 1

RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of the householder and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 40 - FULL VALUE PROTECTION

1. When Full Value Protection is ordered in writing by the customer, carrier will guarantee either replacement of articles lost or damaged while in carrier's custody, reimbursement for full replacement cost (as determined by current market value), or repairs, or the cost of repairs to damaged item(s) to the extent necessary to restore the item to the same condition as when received by the carrier from the shipper. Actual replacement articles, if any, shall consist of articles of like kind and quality without deduction for depreciation.

2. Carrier's maximum liability shall not exceed the released or declared value on the shipment or the full cost of repair to the damaged property, whichever is less. Carrier shall have the option of repair or replacement of damaged articles.

3. All items which are replaced or for which the full current market value has been paid become the property of the carrier.

4; Full Value Protection will be provided by carrier only if shipment is declared at a minimum lump sum of \$10,000.00 and subject to a \$500.00 deductible.

5. Provisions of Rule 20 (Claims) in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 50 (50-T) and Rule 28 (Claims) in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 51 (51-W) when in conflict with this item WILL NOT APPLY when Full Value Protection is provided by carrier.

6. In lieu of rates in Item 325 (Valuation Charges) in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No 50 (50-T) and Item 280 (Valuation Charges) in Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 51 (51-W), the rate for Full Value Protection provided by the carrier will be \$7.50 per \$1,000.00 of coverage or fraction thereof, while in possession of the motor carrier.

ITEM 50 - PACKING AND UNPACKING

Packing and unpacking will be performed on the hourly basis plus the cost of containers (Item 200). Such labor will be charged for using hourly labor rates shown in Section 3, Item 300.

SECTION 2

ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 200 - PACKING CONTAINER CHARGES

(When containers are furnished to shipper by carrier). Rates are in dollars and cents per each unit, except as noted, and are applicable on shipments transported distances of forty (40) miles or less and shipments transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles.

HOURLY RATES

ITEM 300

Applicable to the transportation of Class 1 Shipments (Item 20) traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distance of forty (40) miles and less.

Subject to Notes 1 to 5 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be based on the hourly rates named in Columns 1, 2 or 3.

A Charges for all shipments will be based on the time to travel port-to-port. Hourly rates apply from when vehicle(s) and crew depart the carrier's terminal and travel to the first point of origin, continue with loading the shipment and making any extra pickups or deliveries, traveling between points and to the final destination, unloading the shipment, and the vehicle(s) and crew returning to the carrier's terminal.

NOTE 4 - Minimum Transportation Charge: Sundays and Holidays (any hour): 4 hours at rates named in Column 2. Saturdays (any hour) or Weekdays (5:01PM to 7:59AM): 4 hours at rates named in Column 3. Weekdays (8:00AM to 5:00PM): 4 hours at rates named in Column 2. NOTE 5 - Carrier will supply and charge for a supervisor or supervisors as requested by shippers. When provided, the time for the supervisor or supervisors will be based on the same time as the vehicle(s) and crew. The hourly charge for the supervisor or supervisors will be the charge shown above for Additional Men plus \$10.00.
