Cemetery Ave Bridge Thru Girder Paint System

The subject structure is a girder floorbeam stringer bridge founded on stone masonry abutments. It was constructed in 1961 and carries Cemetery Avenue over CSXT in Philadelphia, PA.

In 2020, a bridge inspection was conducted by McCormick Taylor on behalf of PennDOT District 6-0. Within the inspection report McCormick Taylor notes that the thru-girders have lost 100% of its paint. McCormick Taylor also completed a hands-on inspection of the bridge in March of 2014. At that time they noted that there was 100% section loss of the thru-girders' paint system.

This is consistent with our past experience on the bridge. We agree with the inspection report, the thru-girders no longer have paint on them.
