The Public Utility Commission (PUC) will hold a telephonic public input hearing concerning Aqua Pennsylvania, Inc's application to acquire the water assets of the Borough of Shenandoah/Municipal Authority of the Borough of Shenandoah. The public input hearing will be held on:

Telephonic Public Input Hearing

Customers are invited to present their views via telephone to the PUC, the judge, the company, and public advocates.

If you wish to testify at the telephonic public input hearing, please pre-register by 10:00 a.m. on March 20. If you do not pre-register and provide the information listed below, you may not be able to testify. Individuals will testify in the order in which they pre-register. You may pre-register by email or by phone.

To pre-register by email, please email Judge Watson's legal assistant, Nick Miskanic, at nmiskanic@pa.gov, and provide: (1) your first and last name, (2) the date and time of the hearing at which you wish to testify, (3) the phone number you will be using to call into the public input hearing, and (4) if you require an interpreter to participate in the hearing, the language of the interpreter.

To pre-register by phone, please call Judge Watson's office at 412.565.3550 and leave a message providing: (1) your first and last name, (2) the date and time of the hearing at which you wish to testify, (3) the phone number you will be using to call into the public input hearing, (4) a phone number where you can be reached prior to the hearing if the PUC needs to contact you, (5) your email address, if you have one, and (6) if you require an interpreter to participate in the hearing, the language of the interpreter.

Requests for interpreters: If you require an interpreter, please pre-register as soon as possible. If you register too close to the hearing date, the PUC may not have enough time to arrange for an interpreter. If you request an interpreter, the PUC will make every reasonable effort to have one present.

If you need assistance pre-registering to testify, you may have someone register for you, but they will need to provide the PUC all the information listed above. Additionally, if more than one person in your household would like to testify, one person may pre-register for other individuals in the same household, but the PUC will need the information for each individual.

If you do not wish to testify
