1. Please provide clarification of your intended area of operation. In order for this Commission to accept an application for further processing, the proposed service area must be fully bound, and easily discernible. This may be achieved by the use of municipal boundaries, roads, railroads, or natural boundaries such as rivers and streams, etc. You have indicated an interest in statewide operations; however, you indicate only one location and one vehicle. As stated, your request is unfeasible. Please limit your request ONLY to the regions in which you wish to ORIGINATE service from.

1. - Central PA Medical Transport will be transporting patients in wheelchair and stretcher vans in and between all Pennsylvania Counties.

Our area of operation will be from points in the counties of Lancaster, York, Adams, Lebanon, Chester, Montgomery, Dauphin, Perry, Juniata, Berks, and Cumberland, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

2. Your provided answer to question 5 is inadequate/incomplete. You are expected to provide a plan that satisfies the requirements of 52 Pa Code. You are directed to fully review the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and to provide a summarization of your revised and compliant plan for drivers.

- § 29.503. Age restrictions.
- § 29.504. Driver history
- § 29.505. Criminal history.

We will be hiring three drivers for the start of our transporting services. Then we will hire more drivers to keep up with demand.

- A. All drivers must have a clean driving record. Also, our employees will be required to obtain the EMSVO certification as well.
- B. We will be using an online service to conduct our criminal background checks. That service is Goodhire / Checkr.
- C. Employees will be required to complete the EMSVO and online driver safety training. This will include safe driving habits and defensive driving courses.
- D. We will use an online service to conduct our drivers license and driver history reports. Goodhire / Checkr.
- E. Employees will need to pass a drug screening to be employed. No alcohol use will be permitted.

- Age restrictions – All drivers must be 21 Years of Age.
- Driver History – We will obtain driver history from the appropriate agency of every state in which that person held a motor vehicle operator’s license or permit during the preceding 3 years. Every 12 months from the date of the first report, we will obtain a driver history for each driver from the appropriate agency of the state in which the driver held an operator’s license during the time period. We will keep a copy of driver history reports for at least 2 years on record.
- Criminal History – We will obtain and review a criminal history record from the Pennsylvania State Police and every other state in which the person resided for the last 12 months upon Hiring. Then following receipt of the initial criminal history record, we shall obtain and review a criminal history record for each driver operating under its authority from the Pennsylvania State Police every 2 years from the date of the last criminal history check. Employees will not be hired if they were convicted of a misdemeanor or felony charge. We will keep a copy of the criminal history reports for at least 3 years.
