Dear Attorneys Triscari and Fure:

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) writes to inform you that, upon review of the supplemental materials submitted, it has conditionally accepted for filing the above-captioned application, as amended (Application).

It will be necessary for Pennsylvania-American Water Company – Wastewater Division (PAWC-WD) to serve copies of the Application upon the following entities and then file proof of such service with the Commission, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.57 and 1.58:


1. Each city, borough, town, township, county, and related planning office, which is included, in whole or in part, in the proposed service area;
2. Each water or wastewater utility, municipal corporation or authority which provides water or wastewater collection, treatment, or disposal service to the public and whose service area abuts or is within 1 mile of the service area proposed in the Application; and
3. The Office of Consumer Advocate, Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Department of Environmental Protection’s central and appropriate regional office.

PAWC-WD and Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC) are directed, upon receipt of this letter, to provide individualized notice of the proposed acquisition to all potentially affected PAWC-WD and PAWC customers, consistent with the Commission’s Final Supplemental Implementation Order entered February 28, 2019, at Docket No. M-2016-2543193. PAWC-WD shall inform the Commission when it begins providing such individualized notice. PAWC-WD is also directed to ensure concurrent notice to all current Butler Area Sewer Authority wastewater customers in similar fashion. Additionally, PAWC-WD shall publish the notice once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper having a general circulation in the area involved and file proof of publication with the Commission after publication has occurred.

Upon completion of the conditions established herein, PAWC-WD shall file a letter at this docket indicating satisfaction of these conditions. The Commission will then issue a Secretarial Letter finalizing acceptance of the filing. After final acceptance of the filing, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.14, the Commission will proceed with publishing notice of the Application in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. This matter will receive the attention of the Commission and you will be advised of any further necessary procedure.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration from the actions of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
