

1. Reference the Petition’s Exhibit No. 1, Section 1 – Types and Age of Eligible Property

- a. Confirm that the Second LTIIIP’s projected quantities to be replaced/improved or projected expenditures are not proportionally higher for systems that were acquired under 66 Pa.C.S. § 1329 and lower for other service areas as compared to PAWC-WD’s currently approved LTIIIP.
- b. If PAWC-WD identifies a shift in quantities or expenditures related to question 1.a., above, provide an explanation as to why the shift was appropriate.

2. Reference the Petition’s Exhibit No. 1, Section 2 – Schedule for Planned Repair and Replacement of Eligible Property

- a. Provide a table similar in content and form to Appendix B¹ of PAWC-WD’s LTIIIP in its Petition for Approval of Modification of its Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan, at Docket No. P-2014-2431005, that includes information for each year of the Second LTIIIP.
- b. Provide a table identical in content and form to that requested in question 2.a., above, that provides information for the actual replacements and expenditures for each of the years 2019 through 2022, and projected information for 2023.

3. Reference the Petition’s Exhibit No. 1, Section 4 – Estimate of the Quantity of Property to Be Improved

- a. Reference Table 12 on Page 40. Please confirm that the service laterals mentioned in Table 12 are not customer-owned service laterals.

¹ Note that the LTIIIP that PAWC-WD included in its Petition for Approval of Modification of its Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan inadvertently omitted Appendix B, which was later provided by PAWC-WD in its February 20, 2020, response to a Commission data request.

- b. Reference Table 12 on Page 40. Provide a table similar in content and form to Table 12 that provides information for the actual property replaced/rehabilitated for each of the years 2019 through 2022, and projected information for 2023.
