Certificate No. A-108084, F. 1

1. To transport, as a Class B Carrier, Property between points in the City of Scranton, Lackawanna County, and within three (3) miles of the limits of said City.
2. To transport, as a Class D Carrier, Household Goods in use from points in the City of Scranton, Lackawanna County, to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa;

Rights 1 and 2 subject to the following condition:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport raw silk, materials and finished products of the silk industry.

3. To transport, as a Class B Carrier, Property between points in the City of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, and within an airline distance of three (3) statute miles of the said City limits.
4. To transport, as a Class D Carrier, Household Goods in use from points in the City of Wilkes-Barre, Luzerne County, and within an airline distance of three (3) statute miles of said City limits to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa.
5. To transport, as a Class D Carrier, Surplus Food Commodities for the Office of Public Assistance, Department of Public Welfare (formerly the Department of Public Assistance) from the warehouse in the City of Wilkes-Barre, to points in the Counties of Luzerne, Lackawanna, Bradford, Columbia, Lycoming, Schuylkill and Carbon, and vice versa;

Rights 3, 4 and 5 subject to the following condition:

That no right, power or privilege is granted to transport raw silk materials and finished products to the silk industry, except that the applicant may carry silk and silk products to and from mills or other places of business and railroad stations.

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, household goods in use: (1) from points in the city of Scranton, Lackawanna County, and within an airline distance of three (3) statute miles of the limits of said city to other points in Pennsylvania, and vice versa; (2) between points in the city of Pottsville, Schuylkill County, and within ten (10) miles by the usually traveled highways of the limits of said city and from points in said area to other points in Pennsylvania and vice versa, with right No. 2 subject to the following conditions: (a) that no right, power or privilege is granted to pick up household goods, in use, from points on Highway Route 29 between the borough of Tamaqua and the city of
