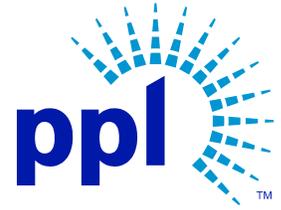

TUS-1 Please provide a fully executed agreement which is signed by all the parties subject to the AIA.

Response The amended and restated Utility Services Agreement for Mutual Assistance filed by PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric”) on March 31, 2023 (the “Agreement”) has been submitted to the Virginia State Corporation Commission (“VSCC”) for approval concurrently with the instant application to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PA PUC”).

Under Virginia law, the Agreement is not valid or effective until it is approved by the VSCC. Va. Code § 56-77(A). In addition, pursuant to Section 3 of this Agreement, the Agreement will not become effective until final approval has been granted by both the VSCC and the PA PUC, whichever occurs later. Consequently, PPL Electric will not execute the Agreement until all regulatory approvals are obtained.

To follow a similar process set forth in the Secretarial Letter approving the currently effective Utility Services Agreement for Mutual Assistance issued October 17, 2018 at Docket No. G-2011-2263689, PPL Electric will file a fully executed copy of the Agreement within 30 days of execution of the Agreement once all regulatory approvals are obtained.
