Explain why the Applicant is seeking a CPC to provide Competitive Access Provider (CAP) services within Pennsylvania when its affiliate, Plenary Broadband Infrastructure PA LLC, is currently also seeking to provide CAP services within Pennsylvania, in addition to the parent company SQF, LLC already holding a CPC for CAP authority.
9. Provide a description of the types of facilities that the Applicant will utilize in providing CAP services within Pennsylvania.
10. Is the Company operating as a public utility in any other states? If so, list what states it is operating in as a public utility and the authorities granted in each state.
