PHILADELPHIA GAS WORKS' MOTION TO CONTINUE

1. By notice dated March 23, 2023, the Commission scheduled a telephonic hearing in this matter for Thursday May 4, 2023 at 10:00 a.m., before Administrative Law Judge Darlene Heep.
2. PGW is still in the process of investigating the issues raised in the Complaint.
