Pursuant to the above-referenced Order, the Commission, *among other things*, directed National Fuel to serve annual LC-LIURP status updates on an annual basis through 2024 ("**Status Update**").

More specifically, the Status Update was to contain reporting on the following: (a) the number of customers served (and projected to be served in each priority level through 2023); (b) total dollars paid out; and (c) total MCFs saved.

The Status Update through the above-referenced date appears on the attached Exhibit A. Importantly, the authorization for the LC-LIURP Pilot expired in January, 2023.

Response: National Fuel has spent a total of \$228,002.78 in on the LC-LIURP Pilot. From this figure, National Fuel spent \$20,375.52 in 2020; \$36,025.94 in 2021; \$152,398.52 in 2022; and \$19,202.80 in 2023.

That is, the jobs completed in the remainder of 2022 and 2023 referenced in the tables on the previous page of this Exhibit A are therefore not included in Table 2, above.

\*\* Calculated using normalized consumption.

\*\*\* Line 1 and Line 2 differ in that, Line 1 includes data for all completed jobs for which National Fuel has 12 months post-consumption data, whereas Line 2 contains information for the subset of LC-LIURP jobs which received full weatherization (i.e., two jobs had furnace repair/replacement only).
