TUS-A-2:

Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 9. Please explain why PECO is only reconductoring 0.8 miles of the 1.4-mile-long Croydon-Burlington 220-30 230 kV Transmission Line.

Response:

The 220-30 line currently utilizes two different conductors. The conductor currently in use for the first 0.8 miles out of Croydon (which is the subject of the instant LON) does not have sufficient capacity to meet the new increased loading requirement. The conductor currently in use for the remaining 0.6 miles of the line meets the increased loading requirements and will therefore remain in place.

Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 11. The project cost estimate is not consistent with the October 5, 2021, PJM TEAC. Please explain.

Response:

PJM requests quarterly project updates on RTEP projects, including but not limited to, engineering progress status, cost estimates, construction updates etc. This process recognizes that cost estimates that are originally provided to PJM are planning-level estimates that will change as the project progresses through design, engineering, and construction. These updates are then publicly posted on PJM's website¹. In its second quarter 2023 project update, PECO provided to PJM the updated total project cost of \$1.3M.

TUS-A-4:

Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 16. Please explain whether the new higher capacity conductors result in additional structural loading on the existing transmission structures. Additionally, please explain whether these transmission structures are adequate for any changes in structural loading.

Response:

The new conductor weighs 66 pounds per 1000' more than the existing conductors, and therefore will apply minimal additional load to the existing transmission structures. The new conductors will be installed at a slightly lower maximum tension than existing conductors. The existing transmission structures are adequate for modified loading conditions. As per PECO's response in Attachment 2, Question 5, conductor clearances were verified to meet the requirements of EPP-2090 and NESC 2017.

Reference the Letter of Notification, Paragraph 26. The description is not consistent with 52 Pa Code § 57.72(d)(1)(i). Please explain.

Response:

There was a transcription error in the portion of Paragraph 26 that summarizes subsection 57.72(d)(1)(i). That first bullet should read:

- 52 Pa Code §57.72(d)(1)(i): **An HV line which is proposed to be located entirely on an existing transmission line right-of-way, so long as the size, character design or configuration of the proposed HV line does not substantially alter the right-of-way. See Attachment 2, PECO answer to Question 12, for evidence that this project does not substantially alter the right-of-way.**

Response:

There was a transcription error in the second bullet of Paragraph 26, which is quoting subsection 57.72(d)(1)(v) and not subsection 57.72(d)(1)(vi). That bullet should read:

- 52 Pa Code §57.72(d)(1)(v): An HV line which is to be reconducted or reconstructed so long as the size, character, design or configuration of the proposed HV line does not substantially alter the right-of-way. *See* Attachment 2, PECO answer to Questions 3, 4, and 12, for a description of the partial reconductoring.



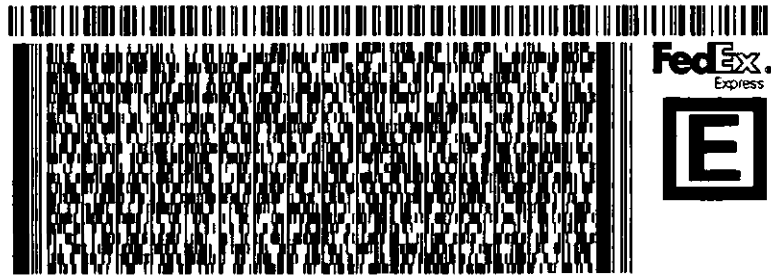

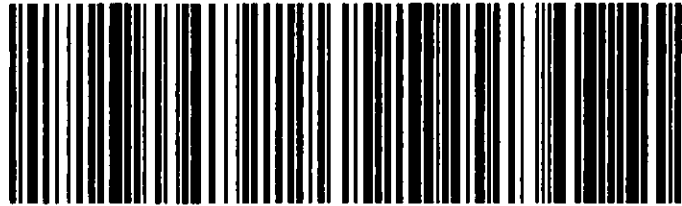
