Dear Sir or Madam of the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania,


I am requesting a stay to delay the installation of a smart meter on my home at 15 Sherman Road Ottsville Pennsylvania, 18942 for the following reasons:

- There are numerous PUC appeals awaiting a decision by the Commonwealth Court that are based on health issues and other arguments which are not fully addressed in the PA Supreme Court ruling. These appeals, if won, could apply to my case as well.
- PUC did not respond to the studies and reports I cited about adverse health effects from smart meter radiation in my March 26, 2019 Rebuttal letter. PUC and First-Med not addressing my significant comments violates the Administrative Procedures Act and deprived me of due process.
- Met-Ed blithely asserts their smart meters comply with all safety requirements. However, they provide no proof of biological safety. Where are those reports of biological safety? I request they be provided to me and this Honorable Court as they go to the very heart of this matter.
- The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) also failed to provide proof of biological safety in the landmark ruling Environmental Health Trust, et al. v. Federal Communications Commission of August 13, 2021. The United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit remanded the case back to FCC to provide a reasoned explanation that non-thermal RF radiation of the type transmitted by smart meters is safe for humans. Now, twenty-one months later FCC has still failed to do so. Why? Until FCC provides a reasoned explanation that non-thermal RF radiation from smart meters is safe, no safe guidelines for smart meter radiation can be deemed to exist.

I respectfully request please a stay be granted in my case until 1) the FCC provides proof that smart meter transmissions are safe for humans sufficient as a matter of Federal law, and 2) the Commonwealth Court rules on the backlog of PUC smart meter appeals, one or more rulings of which might be applicable to my case.

Should you require me to file a Supersedeas or in a manner other than this letter kindly advise please so I can comply. Thank you.
