PETITION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.71, 5.72 and 5.74, the Township of Butler (the “Township”), by and through its attorneys, Obermayer Rebmann Maxwell & Hippel LLP, hereby files with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (the “Commission”) this Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned Application of Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“Pennsylvania-American”) for approval to acquire the wastewater collection and treatment system of Butler Area Sewer Authority (“BASA” or the “Authority”). The Application directly affects the interests of the Township, as co-incorporator of BASA, which are not adequately represented by any existing party. For the reasons that follow, the City respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Petition to Intervene, and in support thereof avers as follows:

1. The Township of Butler is a first-class township located in Butler County, Pennsylvania.
2. The Township’s business address is 290 South Duffy Road, Butler, PA 16001.
3. The Township jointly incorporated BASA together with the City of Butler to serve both municipalities, connect the collection sewers, and expand the sewage treatment plant.

4. While the Township and the City of Butler incorporated BASA to serve both municipalities, the Authority also provides wastewater services to Center Township, East Butler Borough, parts of Connoquenessing Borough, Summit Township, and Oakland Township (the “Service Area”).

5. Nonetheless, the Township is interested in the above-captioned docket because, as stated above, it jointly incorporated the Authority with the City of Butler to serve both municipalities, connect the collection sewers, and expand the sewage treatment plant.

6. The Township supports the Application filed by Pennsylvania-American at this docket.

7. 52 Pa. Code § 5.72 sets forth the eligibility requirements for a party to intervene and provides in part as follows:

(a) Persons. A petition to intervene may be filed by a person claiming a right to intervene or an interest of such nature that intervention is necessary or appropriate to the administration of the statute under which the proceeding is brought. The right or interest may be one of the following:

- (1) A right conferred by statute of the United States or of the Commonwealth.
- (2) An interest which may be directly affected, and which is not adequately represented by existing participants, and as to which the petitioner may be bound by the action of the Commission in the proceeding.
- (3) Another interest of such nature that participation of the petitioner may be in the public interest.

8. The Township seeks intervention in the proceeding for due cause shown as the Township is a joint incorporator of the Authority whose assets Pennsylvania-American seeks approval to acquire with this Application.

9. The Township has a substantial and bona fide interest in the subject matter of this docket and its interests cannot be represented or protected adequately by other existing parties to this docket.

10. As a joint incorporator of BASA, the Township submits that its intervention is in the public interest.

11. The Township intends to play an active role in the Commission's decision-making process and its participation herein will not unduly prejudice any party.

WHEREFORE, the Township of Butler respectfully requests that the Commission grant the instant Petition to Intervene in this proceeding.


