SECTION 1

RULES & REGULATIONS AND ADDITIONAL SERVICES

**ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS**

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

**ITEM 20 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY**

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

**ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE**

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

**ITEM 40 - ADDITIONAL EXPENSES**

Any parking fees incurred at the client's origin or destination or tolls while carrier is traveling in conjunction with the relocation will be the responsibility of the client and added to the carrier's charges.

**ITEM 50 - HANDLING FEE**

Carrier will add a 3.5% handling fee to the final charges when the customer chooses to pay with a credit card.

**ITEM 60 - BULKY ITEMS**

When a piano or safe (including gun safes) is included in the shipment, a handling fee in addition to all other applicable charges will be assessed per item as follows:

Spinet/Console Piano - \$175.00    Baby Grand Piano or Grand Piano - \$225.00

Safe (300 pounds or less) - \$150.00    Safe (301 pounds & over) - \$300.00

When item needs to be moved up or down flights, additional charge is \$75.00 per flight

SPECIAL SERVICES

**ITEM 70 - SPACE RESERVATION & EXPEDITED SERVICE**

SPACE RESERVATION FOR A PORTION OF VEHICLE

Subject to the availability of equipment, shipper may reserve a portion of the capacity of a vehicle by ordering a specific quantity of space, and accepting transportation charges based on actual weight of shipment subject to minimum weights as follows:

300 cubic feet or less - 2,100 pounds

More than 300 cubic feet - Space Reservation to be calculated using 700 pounds per each 100 cubic feet unit or fraction thereof ordered or required.

The total cubic footage for space reservation cannot exceed the cubic footage of available van space in the vehicle being used to transport the shipment.

Bill of Lading and Freight Bill to be marked or stamped:

SPACE RESERVATION \_\_\_\_\_ CU. FT. ORDERED

SIGNATURE REQUIRED FOR SERVICES

Space Reservation for a portion of a vehicle or Expedited Service Reservation will be furnished by carrier only when shipper or his requests such service in writing or the service is required by the mover and the shipper or his agent signs the Bill of Lading indicating that such specific special service was ordered or required.

DISPLAY OF VAN SPACE

The number of cubic feet of van space shall be legibly displayed on each side of the vehicle used by the carrier in rendering service.

NOTE: all shipments subject to weighing provisions.

EXPEDITED SERVICE

1. Expedited Service as used herein means tendering delivery of a shipment of less than 5,000 pounds on or before a specified date.

2. Subject to the availability of equipment for a particular service desired, shippers may obtain expedited service on a shipment of less than 5,000 pounds and transportation charges shall be computed on the basis of 5,000 pounds and tariff rates applicable to 5,000 pounds.

**SECTION 3  
HOURLY RATES**

Subject to Notes 1 to 4 and AA below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVELING CHARGE named in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGE at applicable rates named in Columns 2, 3, and 4.

Hourly rates apply from the time of arrival to first point of origin (continued during all loading, transportation from first point of origin, as well as any extra stops, to final destination & unloading and dismissal of vehicle and men by shipper at destination.

The rates shown below apply to moves traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances of forty (40) miles or less.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) are based on the day or days, or period of days, as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in quarter-hour periods; fractions of one-quarter hour to be considered as one-quarter hour.

NOTE 4 - All moves are subject to a four (4) hours minimum charge based on rates shown in Columns 2, 3 and 4.

NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 15 miles	1/2 hour
16 - 30 miles	1 hour
31 - 45 miles	1 1/2 hours
46 - 60 miles	2 hours

For mileage in excess of 60 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 15 miles

**SECTION 3**  
**TRANSPORTATION RATES**

Rates shown are in dollars and cents per 100 pounds, apply to actual weight (subject to minimum weights as provided in rules herein) and include loading and unloading and the actual movement or transportation of property from origin to destination, but do not include Additional Services and Charges shown in Section 1. These rates apply to shipments traveling between points in Pennsylvania and transported distances in excess of forty (40) miles.

(Rate in Dollars and Cents Per 100 Pounds)

Break Point indicates weight at which a lower charge develops by use of lowest weight and applicable rate in next higher weight bracket.
