
Upon further review of the data provided in response to Information Request No. 1, the Companies discovered that there was an error in the formula used to calculate the data for the Proposed PIP Projected Average Monthly Utility Bills. There was also a data issue for fixed credit where certain data was missing. As a result, the data provided in the table in response to Request No. 1 is incorrect. The Companies have thoroughly checked the rest of the data provided and do not believe that the formula error or missing data has affected any subsequent responses. Accordingly, the Companies submit the attached Amended Response to Information Request No. 1 to replace the response originally submitted on April 25, 2023.

Considering the corrected information provided in the Amended Response to Information Request No. 1, the Companies anticipate that the stakeholders in this matter will request an extension for the deadline for comments. The Companies have no objection to this request.

The Companies apologize for any inconvenience that this calculation error may have caused and thank you in advance for your consideration of the attached Amended Response to Request No. 1.



1.
