Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

Pursuant to the above-referenced Order, the Commission, *among other things*, directed National Fuel to provide semi-annual reports on Neighbor for Neighbor ("**NFN**") spending by June 1 and December 1 of each year during the time period covered by National Fuel's 2022-2026 Plan, starting in 2023. (the "**Semi-Annual Report**"). On June 1, 2023, National Fuel filed the first such Semi-Annual Report (covering the time period from October 1, 2022-April 1, 2023) (the "**June 1, 2023 Semi-Annual Report**").

In the June 1, 2023 Semi-Annual Report, National Fuel also indicated that it would make a supplemental filing within two weeks to report on NFN grant *amounts* by eligibility category and the number of NFN grants awarded to the 0-150% and 151-200% FPIG eligibility groups (the "**Supplemental NFN Report**").

The above-referenced Supplemental NFN Report (for time period covering October 1, 2022-April 1, 2023) is attached hereto for filing.
