

Request for Information

1.) In the applicant's Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action, the applicant states that the request to obtain certification as a "moving company," i.e., transportation of household goods in use, stems from the Applicant's owners lending Mountz Disposal personnel to provide the "manpower" need to physically move/carry personal property from one room within a retirement community to another. As such, there is a question of whether the applicant needs Commission authority. Household Goods in Use authority would only be required if the applicant intends to transport household goods in use between points in this Commonwealth **by motor vehicle**. Due to the previous information provided by the applicant, we must ask for clarification on what service(s) they intend to provide to the public of this Commonwealth.

A) What type of moves do you intend to provide? Would you restrict yourself to retirement homes? Will you be offering service to other private residences? Will your moving services include a vehicle? Please, be specific in your description.

B) Also, do you intend to offer moves in excess of 40 miles?

2.) If you are being compensated to haul property points in this Commonwealth by motor vehicle, you are required to obtain Property authority from this Commission. Based upon the information that you have provided, it would appear that you also intend to offer the Property service. If this is the case, then you will also need to file an application for Property authority. An application can be found on the Commission's website at:

**Definition of property under PUC jurisdiction: New Household Goods items from a store, office furniture/office moves, recyclable items moved within PA for compensation providing a motor vehicle for that service.**
